## PLANNING COMMISSION APPLICATIONS SOUGHT DEADLINE SEPTEMBER 20, 2023

Chino Hills, CA – Residents interested in serving on the Planning Commission are invited to complete an application. Mayor Peter Rogers will review the applications and nominate an individual to fill a vacancy created after Planning Commissioner Sean Phan submitted his resignation. Applications must be returned to the City Clerk's Office on the second floor at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 20, 2023.

The Planning Commission meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. to review issues related to the physical development of the City. The Commission reviews subdivision maps, site plans, amendments to the Development Code and General Plan, residential designs, design standards, and development standards.
