CITY OF CHINO HILLS BEGINS TORREY PINES PARK ENHANCEMENT PROJECT - PARK WILL BE UNAVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC USE OCTOBER 2 THROUGH 6

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is beginning work on the Torrey Pines Park Enhancement Project, located at 5011 Torrey Pines Road. The City is making a significant investment of \$350,000 towards park improvements to add new amenities for residents to enjoy and encourage increased community use of the park. Work will begin on Monday, October 2, and the project is expected to be completed in December 2023.

Enhancements include a new playground area, a new trellis over the picnic area, installation of additional lighting for increased security, a new metal roof and exterior repairs for the existing restroom, and parking lot enhancements. Work will be ongoing through December 2023 and the park will be temporarily unavailable during periods of construction. The first part of construction will begin on Monday, October 2 and the park will be unavailable for public use through Friday, October 6 for sidewalk repairs and parking lot rehabilitation.

The total project cost is estimated to be \$350,000 funded by a generous \$50,000 donation from the Chino Hills Community Foundation and the remaining \$300,000 is being funded by the respective Community Facilities District.
