## CITY OF CHINO HILLS SKATE PARK RENOVATION PROJECT SECOND COMMUNITY INPUT WORKSHOP TO BE HELD WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 21

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is continuing the community engagement process for the Skate Park Renovation Project and will host a second community workshop on Wednesday, February 21 at 6:00 p.m. in the Chino Hills City Council Chambers. During this workshop, the City's consultant will provide an overview of the community feedback collected from the first workshop and online survey held in November 2023, and present initial skate park design options for attendees to provide feedback on. Following the in-person workshop, an online survey will be available from Wednesday, February 21 through Wednesday, March 6 to gather additional community feedback on the conceptual designs.

The City, in partnership with global leading skate park design and construction company Newline Skateparks, is aiming to engage the community and update the existing 20-year-old skate park to make it place that is inclusive and fun for people all of ages and abilities. The project will also add lighting, shade structures, seating, repair existing areas, and look at expanding the footprint at the undeveloped north end of the park to increase its functionality.

The project cost thus far is \$250,000, with \$125,000 being funded by the City's General Fund and another \$125,000 provided with generous support from San Bernardino County Fourth District Supervisor Curt Hagman's Office.
