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CITY OF CHINO HILLS EASTER EGG-CITEMENT IS SATURDAY, MARCH 30 - REGISTER TO BE A CRAFT VENDOR BY FRIDAY, MARCH 15

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills invites residents to the annual Easter Egg-Citement event on Saturday, March 30 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm at Chino Hills Community Park, located at 3280 Eucalyptus Avenue. The free event includes egg hunts, photos with the Easter Bunny, a craft fair featuring homemade and boutique items, musical entertainment, activities, and refreshments.

The Easter Egg Hunt schedule is as follows: Infants to two-year-old children will begin at 10:30 am, three- to four-years-old will begin at 11:00 am, five- to six-years-old at 11:30 am, seven- to eight-years-old at noon, and nine- to 12-years-old at 12:30 pm. Parents will be allowed to assist children in the first three egg hunts for those six years of age and younger. The City will provide bags for the Easter egg hunts. Outside baskets and bags are not permitted.

For children with autism, on the spectrum, or any special needs, the City will host a smaller, more-controlled egg hunt in a designated area at the event from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm. Children will be able to gather eggs at their own pace. Eggs will be placed both on the ground and on top of tables to make them accessible for children in wheelchairs. The City will provide bags for all children and butterfly catchers for children in wheelchairs that would prefer to gather eggs from the ground.

There will also be an Easter craft fair featuring handmade craft items by local businesses available for purchase. Applications are now available online for vendors who would like to participate. The deadline to register to be a vendor at the event is Friday, March 15.
