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FREE BULKY ITEM DROP-OFF EVENT TO ENCOURAGE HOUSEHOLD CLEANUP ON SATURDAY, MARCH 9 AT THE SHOPPES

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills, in partnership with Waste Management (WM), will host a free bulky item drop-off event on Saturday, March 9 from 8:00 am to noon at The Shoppes overflow parking lot. Residents can properly dispose of bulky items, appliances, and electronic waste for free. All vehicles must enter City Center Drive off Boys Republic Drive near the Library.

Items being accepted at the drop-off event include air conditioners, appliances, barbecues/patio furniture, box springs and mattresses, bundled branches, chairs/couches/tables, electronic waste (e-waste), and unbagged green waste. Items that will not be accepted at the event include auto parts (used oil, filters, and tires), building materials, household hazardous waste (paint, cleaning supplies, and batteries), and household chemicals.

Proof of Chino Hills residency is required in the form of a photo ID. Vehicles are limited to cars, pickup trucks, station wagons, vans, and SUVs. Company vehicles will be turned away. Residents with trailers and/or enclosed storage trucks can pick up a voucher at the event for free disposal at the transfer station in Pomona.
