CITY OF CHINO HILLS SUMMER 2024 VOLUNTEEN APPLICATIONS NOW AVAILABLE

Chino Hills, CA – High school students looking for summer volunteer opportunities are encouraged to apply for the City of Chino Hills 2024 Summer <u>Volunteen Program</u> by Monday, April 29. The City's Community Services Department is looking for enthusiastic teens who want to volunteer their time in various summer recreation programs including mobile recreation, special events, summer day camp, and youth sports.

The Volunteen program will run from Monday, June 3 through Friday, August 2. Applicants must be in grades 9 through 11 as of fall 2024, reside in or attend a high school in Chino Hills, and be available to volunteer a minimum of 10 to 25 hours per week starting June 3. Volunteens who are selected and successfully complete the program will receive a certificate of appreciation including total hours volunteered, a letter of recommendation, and recognition at a Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting. Volunteens will also be rewarded with a Volunteen Party at the end of the summer to celebrate all their hard work.

Completed applications will be accepted through Monday, April 29, or until the first 60 applications have been received. Applications must be typed and submitted in person to the Chino Hills Community Center located at 14250 Peyton Drive. Applicants will be required to interview before being formally accepted into the program and up to 45 teens will be selected.
