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CHINO HILLS RESIDENTS ARE INVITED TO CELEBRATE THE GRAND REOPENING AND NEW INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUND AT CROSSROADS PARK ON TUESDAY, MAY 7

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills invites the community to celebrate the grand reopening of Crossroads Park, located at 2765 Chino Hills Parkway, on Tuesday, May 7 from 6:00 to 7:00 pm. The City's new inclusive playground will be unveiled during an opening ceremony at 6:15 pm and the community is invited to experience the new playground and improved park amenities following the ceremony. Light refreshments, crafts for children, and giveaway items will be available to Chino Hills residents while supplies last.

The renovated park features new state-of-the-art inclusive playground equipment designed to accommodate individuals with mobility challenges and sensory sensitivities, ramps, transfer areas, accessible pathways, improved lighting, new picnic tables and benches, new exercise equipment, an expanded parking lot, and resurfaced tennis courts. Improvements and repairs were also made to the existing restrooms and gazebo area.

The total project cost for the Crossroads Park renovation project is \$1.275 million. The inclusive playground and park renovation was made possible thanks to the generous support and \$125,000 donation received from the Chino Hills Community Foundation, with Foundation support from the Howard and Nikki Applebaum Foundation and the Jack and Gloria Kramer Family Foundation. Additional funding of \$210,000 was provided by the California Department of Parks and Recreation Proposition 68 Per Capita Grant Program and the remaining \$815,000 was funded by the City's General Fund and Community Facilities District Regional Fund, and \$125,000 by American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding.
