CITY OF CHINO HILLS SEEKS INPUT ON GENERAL PLAN UPDATE
TO DETERMINE COMMUNITY'S VISION FOR THE FUTURE OF THE CITY –
NEW SAFETY ELEMENT SURVEY AVAILABLE THROUGH JUNE 30

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is in the process of updating its General Plan and is seeking input to determine the community's vision for the future of Chino Hills. Public input is an important part of the process, and the City is conducting several community surveys the public is encouraged to take and provide feedback. A new survey focused on the Safety Element of the General Plan is now available online at www.chinohills.org/GeneralPlan through Sunday, June 30. The Safety Element addresses protection of the community from possible risks including flooding, earthquakes, wildland fires, and more.

The community can also visit the City's information booth at the summer Concerts in the Park series on Wednesdays, June 12, 19, and 26 at Veterans Park starting at 7:00 pm to learn more about the City's General Plan Update and provide input on the Safety Element. Residents who visit the booth and complete the survey in person or show that they have completed the survey online will receive a free City giveaway including an emergency paracord bracelet on June 12, and a travel-size first aid kit on the June 19 and 26 dates, while supplies last.

The General Plan is based on the community's vision for the future of the City of Chino Hills. From the time of its incorporation, the City has envisioned itself as a community with a high quality of life while preserving its rural character. The General Plan update will refine the City's vision to maintain the City's high quality of life and to meet the challenges of today. The City previously gathered community feedback on the Housing Element Update, the vision statements, and the Environmental Justice element included in the General Plan.
