CHINO HILLS CITY COUNCIL ELECTION NOMINATION PERIOD OPENS JULY 15

Chino Hills, CA – The General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, for the election of two City Council members for full terms of four years each, one each from Districts 3 and 5 currently represented by incumbents Art Bennett and Cynthia Moran respectively. The nomination period for offices participating in the November 5 Election will open on Monday, July 15, 2024. The nomination period ends at 4:30 pm on Friday, August 9, and may be extended to Wednesday, August 14, for contests in which an eligible incumbent officeholder does not file.

The General Municipal Election will fill two seats on the Chino Hills City Council:

- City Council Member representing District 3 for a full term of four years.
- City Council Member representing District 5 for a full term of four years.

To be eligible to hold office as a City Council Member, a person must be at least 18 years old and a registered voter residing within the boundaries of the district they seek to represent at the time the nomination papers are issued. Residents may identify the district in which they reside in by visiting www.chinohills.org/FindYourDistrict and entering their address.

All forms required for nomination and election to the City Council in the City of Chino Hills are furnished by and filed with the City Clerk. Persons considering filing to become a candidate are required to make an appointment with the City Clerk to obtain the nomination papers, review the filing requirements, and ask questions about the process.

Appointments can be made in person by visiting the City Clerk's office, located on the second floor of City Hall at 14000 City Center Drive, or by contacting the City Clerk by email at cbalz@chinohills.org or by phone at (909) 364-2624.
