ENTRIES ARE NOW BEING ACCEPTED FOR THE 32ND ANNUAL CHINO HILLS BOAT PARADE ON FRIDAY, DECEMBER 13 – NEW PARADE ROUTE THIS YEAR

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills invites residents and local groups to register to participate in the 32nd annual <u>Chino Hills Boat Parade</u> taking place on Friday, December 13. Decorated boats and non-boat entries such as bands, equestrians, specialty vehicles and more are encouraged to apply to participate by Wednesday, November 27. This year's Boat Parade will begin at 7:00 pm and will follow a new route beginning at City Center Drive and Shoppes Drive. Boats will then travel south down City Center Drive, south on Peyton Drive, and then turn around at Eucalyptus Drive before heading back north on Peyton Drive.

The registration packet including general information, an application, and required documents is available online at www.chinohills.org/BoatParade. Registration packets are also available for pick-up at the Chino Hills Community Center located at 14250 Peyton Drive, and in the City Hall Recreation Office located at 14000 City Center Drive. A completed registration packet must be submitted and approved for participation by Wednesday, November 27. There is a mandatory meeting for parade participants on Wednesday, December 11 at 7:00 pm at the Chino Hills Police Department located at 14077 Peyton Drive.

During the parade, announcers will be located along the route and will share information about parade entries. Spectator viewing will be allowed on City Center Drive, Shoppes Drive, and Peyton Drive.
