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CITY OF CHINO HILLS VELLANO PARK CLOSED FOR PARKING LOT EXPANSION AND PICKLEBALL COURT RESURFACING BEGINNING MONDAY, DECEMBER 2

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is beginning a project at Vellano Park, located at 16321 Aviano Lane, to expand the parking lot and resurface the pickleball courts. The park will be temporarily closed beginning Monday, December 2, and is expected to reopen by the end of January 2025, weather permitting. During this time, the park and all amenities will not be accessible to the public including the pickleball courts, basketball courts, gazebos, restrooms, and playground.

Residents are encouraged to use the newly resurfaced pickleball courts and existing basketball courts at Grand Avenue Park, located at 1301 Grand Avenue. There are also 17 other parks throughout the City that offer half or full basketball courts for residents to enjoy during this time. The expansion of the parking lot will add 15 new parking spaces to the existing lot, bringing the total to 35 spaces, including the two existing handicap spaces. The total project cost is \$255,000 funded by the Vellano Landscape and Lighting District. Closure dates may adjust due to weather conditions, availability of supplies, or construction delays.
