## CHINO HILLS COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SEEKS APPLICANTS FOR SUMMER DAY CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS – DEADLINE TO APPLY IS FEBRUARY 27

Chino Hills, CA – The <u>Chino Hills Community Foundation</u> (Foundation) is seeking applicants for the 2025 <u>Bill Hughes Memorial Scholarship</u> which helps cover fees for children to attend the City of Chino Hills Summer Day Camp program. The City's Summer Day Camp offers a safe, fun, active, and educational summer environment for children ages 6 to 12. The Foundation funds scholarships to help economically disadvantaged youth participate in the program. Applications are being accepted through Thursday, February 27.

The Summer Day Camp Program runs from June 2 through August 1 and takes place at the Mystic Canyon and Grand Avenue Park Community Buildings. Throughout the nine-week program, children participate in indoor and outdoor activities such as arts and crafts, sports, games, indoor activities, and the opportunity for children to make new friendships. Children are supervised by experienced, caring, and responsible camp leaders.

Foundation scholarships are available to eligible Chino Hills residents ages 6 to 12. Eligibility is based upon a combination of family size and household annual gross income with priority given to first time applicants. Scholarships are awarded to cover the total cost of one session of camp. Location preference will be considered but will be based on program availability.
