MOBILE PET VACCINATION AND MICROCHIP CLINIC ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 28 AT THE CHINO HILLS COMMUNITY CENTER

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills in partnership with the Inland Valley Humane Society (IVHS), will host a mobile vaccination and microchip clinic for dogs and cats on Friday, February 28 from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm outdoors at the Chino Hills Community Center gazebo, located at 14250 Peyton Drive. Single vaccines will be offered at costs ranging from \$10 to \$40, as well as combination packages from \$22 to \$32, and microchipping for \$30 per pet. No advance reservations required.

In Chino Hills, all dogs over four months old are required to be microchipped under the City's Getting 2 Zero program to increase the likelihood of lost pets being identified and returned to their rightful owners quickly. The City provides a rebate of up to \$30 for dogs properly licensed. To learn more about the microchip rebate program and how to request a rebate, visit www.chinohills.org/Getting2Zero.

Payment will be accepted on-site by card or cash. The event is first-come, first-served. Single vaccinations will be \$10 for rabies, \$15 for Bordetella, \$15 for DHPP, \$18 for FVRCP, and a \$40 influenza vaccine for dogs only. Dogs must be on a leash and cats must be brought in carriers or will be turned away. Any pets that cannot be safely restrained will be turned away.
