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HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS INVITED TO APPLY TO SERVE AS STUDENT MEMBER ON CITY OF CHINO HILLS PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION BY FRIDAY, APRIL 4

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills invites high school students looking to gain experience in local government and community service to apply to serve as a Student Member on the Chino Hills Parks and Recreation Commission. The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 6:00 pm to discuss topics related to parks, recreation, trails, community events, wildlife preservation, and programming. Commissioners also collaborate with community sports organizations and provide input on park and facility designs. Applications are [available online](#) and are due by Friday, April 4 at 4:00 pm.

The Student Member position is a non-voting position open to Chino Hills residents who attend high school on a full-time basis, are juniors or seniors during the 2025/2026 school year, and are in good academic standing. The selected student will be appointed to serve a one-year term starting in May 2025 through April 30, 2026.

Applications are available online at www.chinohills.org/ParksandRecApplication, in-person at City Hall located at 14000 City Center Drive, and have been provided to Ruben S. Ayala and Chino Hills High Schools. Completed applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's Office on the second floor of City Hall by the deadline. Mayor Art Bennett will interview applicants and plans to recommend an appointment to the City Council at their April 22 meeting.
