CITY OF CHINO HILLS INVITES RESIDENTS TO PROVIDE INPUT ON LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN THROUGH APRIL 17

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is in the process of updating its local Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) for 2025 and is seeking public input on the draft plan now through Thursday, April 17. The HMP is an important document that identifies actions and strategies to address natural and man-made disasters or hazards and reduce the potential negative impacts on residents, businesses, and infrastructure.

Public input is an important part of the process in ensuring the City has a disaster preparedness plan that addresses and reflects the diverse needs of the Chino Hills community. Residents, businesses, and community members are invited to review the draft plan and submit comments online, by email, by mail, or in person at designated locations. The draft plan and comment form are available online at www.chinohills.org/HMP. Printed copies can also be reviewed at City Hall, the Chino Hills Community Center, and the James S. Thalman Chino Hills Branch Library.

The public review period is open now through Thursday, April 17. All comments received will be reviewed and considered for possible inclusion in the final HMP. The updated plan will then be submitted to state and federal emergency management agencies for approval and presented to the Chino Hills City Council for adoption.
