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ANNUAL VILA BORBA DOG PARK TURF MAINTENANCE CLOSURES AND IMPACTS

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills will be performing routine annual turf maintenance and renovation at the Vila Borba Dog Park, located at 17001 Amadora Drive. Starting Monday, April 7, the large dog side of the dog park will be closed for renovation of the existing turf and is expected to reopen by Friday, May 2. During this time, the small dog side of the park will remain open and be separated into two sides with portable fencing, so both small and large dogs may still enjoy visiting the dog park.

Following the turf renovation of the large dog side, the small dog side of the park will be closed for maintenance and treatment beginning Monday, May 5 and is expected to reopen on Friday, May 30. During this time, the large dog side of the park will remain open and be separated into two sides with portable fencing for both large and small dogs. Each of the large and small dog areas have two access gates to remain separated while entering and exiting the park, and temporary signage will direct dogs to the proper side during the renovation. Closures and dates may adjust due to weather conditions, availability of supplies, or construction delays.
