CHINO HILLS KICKS OFF A SUMMER OF FREE FAMILY FUN WITH CONCERTS AND MOVIES IN THE PARK

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills popular Concerts in the Park and Movies in the Park series returns beginning in early June. These free, family-friendly events offer residents a full season of live music and outdoor movies designed to create memorable summer evenings.

The eight-week <u>Concerts in the Park</u> series kicks off on Wednesday, June 11 at 7:00 pm with live music by Upstream playing Caribbean Rhythm and continues every Wednesday through July 30 with a different headliner performing each week. All concerts are held outdoors at Veterans Park, located at 14877 Eucalyptus Avenue. Refreshments from food vendors will be available for purchase as well as community informational booths. New this year the City's informational booth will offer fun, glow-in-the-dark items available for purchase.

As part of the concert series, the City will host its annual <u>Independence Celebration</u> on Wednesday, July 2. Festivities will begin at 5:00 pm and include games, entertainment, community booths and live music beginning at 6:30 pm by DSB, a Journey-tribute band.

Movies in the Park will kick off for seven weeks on Thursday, June 12 at 8:00 pm with a screening of *Inside out 2* and continue screening a different movie every Thursday through July 31, except for Thursday, July 3 when there will be no event. Movies will be shown outdoors at the Chino Hills Community Center, located at 14250 Peyton Drive. Activities will begin at 6:30 pm, and movies begin at 8:00 pm. All films are rated PG. Concessions including popcorn, candy, and ice cream will be available onsite for purchase (cash only) and all proceeds will support the City's teen programs and the Volunteen end of summer celebration.

Admission to all concerts and movies is free. Seating is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Attendees should bring their own lawn chairs and blankets. Out of courtesy to all guests, umbrellas, canopies, or any other large objects that obstruct the view of other guests are not allowed.
