NATIONAL NIGHT OUT RETURNS TO CHINO HILLS ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 5

REGISTER BY TUESDAY, JULY 22 TO RECEIVE A FREE NEIGHBORHOOD KIT

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills' award-winning National Night Out (NNO) program returns on Tuesday, August 5 from 6:00 to 9:00 pm. This annual community-building campaign is part of a nationwide effort to strengthen relationships between neighbors, law enforcement, and public safety, making communities safer and more caring places to live.

Each year, Chino Hills neighborhoods participate by hosting potlucks, ice cream socials, block parties, and family-friendly activities. These events are hosted independently by residents and are not organized by the City. Residents who register their event by Tuesday, July 22 at www.chinohills.org/NNO will receive a free organizing kit (while supplies last) including an NNO banner, customized flyers, giveaways for kids, and more. During the evening, Chino Hills City Council Members, City staff, Chino Hills Police Deputies, Chino Valley Fire District personnel with their engines, and McGruff the Crime Dog and Sparky the Fire Dog will try to visit as many registered events as possible.

Residents who are interested in attending a NNO event in their neighborhood are encouraged to host their own individual event or work with a neighborhood group, such as a homeowner's association or neighborhood watch group, to organize one. While events are registered with the City, each gathering is planned and hosted independently by the registered host(s). When registering, event hosts can choose to open their event to guests from nearby neighbors or keep it limited to their own.
