CITY OF CHINO HILLS FREE AFTER-SCHOOL MOBILE RECREATION PROGRAM BEGINS SCHOOL YEAR SCHEDULE ON MONDAY, AUGUST 11

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills is rolling into the new school year with a brand-new Mobile Recreation vehicle which will continue to provide free, fun, and safe after-school programming to neighborhoods throughout the community. The new vehicle, featuring a fresh new look and upgraded equipment, will begin its school year schedule on Monday, August 11, visiting five different local parks each week.

The Mobile Recreation program provides free activities for children in Kindergarten through 6th grade, including arts and crafts, homework help, sports, and games, in a welcoming environment. The new upgraded vehicle was made possible thanks to generous donations totaling \$150,000, including \$100,000 from San Bernardino County Supervisor Curt Hagman, and \$50,000 from the Chino Hills Community Foundation.

The Mobile Recreation Program operates as a drop-in program, allowing children to sign themselves in and out during program hours with prior parent consent and emergency information on file. All participants must register at the beginning of each school year, even if they have participated in previous years. Registration is valid through the end of the school year, and is required again for summer programming. Registration is available online at www.chinohills.org/MobileRec or in person at the Chino Hills Community Center.

Mobile Recreation is closed on major holidays and Chino Valley Unified School District holidays or days off. The schedule may be modified due to weather or City events. There will be no Mobile Recreation service the week of August 4 through 8 as staff prepare for the school-year launch. Summer hours end on Friday, August 1.
