VOTER INFORMATION FOR THE NOVEMBER 4 STATEWIDE SPECIAL ELECTION

Chino Hills, CA – Registered voters in San Bernardino County will cast their ballots in October and November for the November 4, 2025, Statewide Special Election. The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters began mailing voter information guides and vote-by-mail ballots to registered voters on October 6, and early voting began October 6 as well. This Election does not include any City Council seats, the next scheduled election for City Council members will take place in 2026.

To participate in the elections, U.S. citizens ages 18 years or older must register to vote. The last day to register to vote in the November 5 Election is October 20. Online voter registration and information is available at RegisterToVote.CA.gov. Voter registration forms are also available at City Hall. For those who miss the registration deadline, registration and in-person voting can be done at the Registrar of Voters office, an Early Vote site, or at a polling place on Election Day.

Vote-by-mail ballots can be returned by mail or in-person to a secure ballot drop box, a voting location, or the County elections office by 8:00 p.m. on November 4. There is an official Election Ballot Drop Box located in front of the Chino Hills Branch Library at 14020 City Center Drive. The Chino Hills City Hall is an official drop-off location for vote-by-mail ballots. Voters can return their ballots to a secure indoor election box during regular business hours to the City Clerk's Office at City Hall. The City Clerk's Office will also be open on Election Day, November 4, from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. For more information on the November 4 election visit www.chinohills.org/Election.
