CITY SECURES TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER 15250 WOODGLEN DRIVE

On December 27, 2012, San Bernardino County Superior Court Judge Ben T. Kayashima issued a temporary restraining order preventing Los Angeles Hermas, Inc., Hai Yong Wu and Yi Wang from occupying, habiting or residing at the property located at 15250 Woodglen Drive in the City of Chino Hills and from performing any work, construction, rehabilitation or restoration at the property without first obtaining a permit from the City of Chino Hills, or from otherwise operating a hotel use in violation of the Chino Hills Municipal Code and creating a public nuisance. Judge Kayashima also ordered Los Angeles Hermas, Inc., Hai Yong Wu and Yi Wang to appear in Department R12 of the San Bernardino Superior Court at 8:30 a.m. on January 17, 2013 to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be ordered restraining and enjoining them from all of the above-described activities at the Woodglen Drive property pending a trial on the merits of the City's code enforcement action.
