VOTERS MUST RETURN BALLOTS IN SPECIAL ELECTION BY TUESDAY, MARCH 5th

The City of Chino Hills' first all-mail election process to fill a vacant seat on the City Council is underway. Ballots must be received by the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters by Tuesday, March 5th. Voters who wish to mail the ballot should do so by Friday, March 1st. To avoid any concern about mail delivery, voters may drop off their ballot at Chino Hills City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive; or at the James S. Thalman Chino Hills Branch Library, 14020 City Center Drive. City Hall will be open to receive ballots on Election Day, Tuesday, March 5th from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. City Hall hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Friday, March 1st and from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Monday, March 4th.
