### APRIL 21 SPRING HOME TOUR BENEFITS COMMUNITY CENTER

The Chino Hills Community Foundation's Spring Home Tour returns this year on Sunday, April 21 and will showcase a selection of properties that bring to life the dynamic community of Chino Hills.

Tours will take place from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. with a wine reception to follow from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the historic McCoy Equestrian and Recreation Center. Tickets are \$45 per person. Proceeds from the event will contribute to the Foundation's ongoing effort to raise \$250,000 to furnish the City's new [17,000 square-foot Community Center](#).

"Chino Hills is a vibrant and diverse community," said Mayor Peter Rogers, chair of the Foundation. "Our tour this year reflects and celebrates that while raising funds to continue this legacy for generations to come."

With a nod to the City's equestrian heritage, guests will have the opportunity to tour a ranch-style home that features an equestrian training ground where demonstrations will take place throughout the day. The tour will continue to two grand custom properties, situated in different parts of the City. All three properties provide an insider's look at the creativity and customs of the homeowners.

"We are so grateful to these three families for opening up their homes for a good cause," said City Council Member Cynthia Moran, vice chair of the Foundation.

The tours are self-guided, and numerous docents will be on-hand to share information about the homes. The wine reception will feature passed hors d'oeuvres and a dessert bar prepared by



students from The Collins College of Hospitality Management at Cal Poly Pomona. Guests will also have the opportunity to buy raffle tickets and enjoy live music by Give Up The Junk, a Chino Hills youth band.

Founded in 2008, the Chino Hills Community Foundation is committed to enhancing the quality of life in the City through local philanthropy that benefits all citizens. In addition to the Spring Home Tour, the Foundation is selling customizable bricks to raise funds for the Community Center. Bricks, which will be installed in the entryway to the new Community Center, will be available for purchase at the reception.
