TRASH SERVICE RESUMES - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 10th

Chino Hills Disposal has reported that the strike (on Tuesday, April 9) is over and the drivers have returned to work. For those residential customers whose trash was not picked up on Tuesday, they are advised to put the trash cans away until their next regular trash day, next Tuesday. Any extra trash should be bagged and placed next to the automated trash cans on trash pickup day. Commercial collection will be handled similar as to when there is a holiday. Chino Hills Disposal will service Tuesday's routes, as well as part of Wednesday's routes today, doubling-up on collection throughout the remainder of the week, so that we are caught up with all routes by Friday. Chino Hills Disposal has issued an apology for the inconvenience to residents and businesses.
