### **CHINO HILLS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION – APRIL 27<sup>th</sup>**

The annual Chino Hills Household Hazardous Waste Collection will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 27<sup>th</sup> at the site of the former Chino Hills City Yard, 14575 Pipeline Avenue. Waste brought before 9:00 a.m. will not be accepted. Participants must provide identification to confirm they live within the County of San Bernardino. Bring unwanted motor oil, used oil filters, antifreeze, auto and household batteries, paint products, household cleaners, pesticides, fertilizers, pool chemicals, fluorescent light tubes, and medication. The waste must be properly labeled or in its original container. The containers must not be leaking and may not exceed five gallons. The amount of waste per visit cannot exceed 15 gallons or 125 pounds. Only household hazardous waste will be accepted at the free collection. Commercial or business waste will not be accepted. Radioactive or explosive waste, asbestos, infectious waste, medical waste, and microwave ovens are also not accepted. Chino Hills residents may call 1-866-238-2444 to arrange for disposal of televisions, computer monitors, and other electronic wastes.
