SUNDAY NIGHT CONCRETE POUR AT COMMUNITY CENTER RAINED OUT RESCHEDULED TUESDAY NIGHT / WEDNESDAY MORNING

The concrete foundation for the City of Chino Hills' new community center on Peyton Drive, across the street from Ayala High School, will be poured overnight from Tuesday, May 7th to the early morning hours of Wednesday, May 8th. The pour was rained out on Sunday night and had to be rescheduled. The City has allowed the contractor to complete the pour during the early morning hours because there are no homes nearby and it will reduce the impacts to Ayala High School traffic and the daytime motoring public. It will take about 130 cement mixer loads to deliver a total of 1,300 yards of cement to complete the 17,000 s.f. foundation in about seven hours.
