CITY SEEKS COMMUNITY INPUT AND IDEAS ON ACTIVITIES, PROGRAMS, AND EVENTS AT NEW COMMUNITY CENTER AUGUST 22nd

The City of Chino Hills is seeking community input on the types of activities, programs, and events that residents would like to see offered at the new 17,000 s.f. Community Center, set to open late in the Fall of 2013.
