APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE FOR YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - AUG. 5th

The City of Chino Hills will accept applications for the Chino Hills Community

Foundation Youth Scholarship Program starting on Monday, August 5th. The scholarships are designed to help economically-disadvantaged youth participate in City-sponsored Recreation classes, programs, and special events. Funding has been provided by the Chino Hills Community Foundation which was formed in 2008 to support cultural, educational, and recreational projects in Chino Hills.

Children 17 years of age and younger who qualify, and are selected, will be awarded \$125 per year to be used for Recreation classes and special events. There are a limited number of scholarships available and participants must meet income eligibility requirements. Income levels must be at or below established maximum gross income levels based on HUD (Housing and Urban Development Department) guidelines:
