EUCALYPTUS AVENUE TRAIL CLOSURES DURING PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION AUGUST – DECEMBER

A section of the Eucalyptus Avenue Trail Loop in Chino Hills will be closed from August 19th through December 20th due to pipeline construction. The trail closure starts at Chino Hills Community Park, 3280 Eucalyptus Avenue, and continues up the slope above the park and behind the Galloping Hills neighborhood. The Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA) has closed the Eucalyptus Trail Loop in Chino Hills in order to install a 30" diameter pipe that will feed recycled water into the reservoir under construction. The trail is open west of the IEUA reservoir construction site. Signage has been posted.

The new pipeline and recycled water reservoir will help to ensure water reliability in the basin by providing recycled water for landscaping to area schools, parks, medians and businesses. Recycled water provides an additional water source for irrigation. Funding for water recycling projects is provided by the California State Water Resources Control Board and the Environmental Protection Agency.
