OPEN SPACE WORKSHOP SET TO DISCUSS OPEN SPACE ENCROACHMENTS – OCTOBER 24th

The City of Chino Hills will hold a public Open Space Workshop to discuss open space encroachment issues on Thursday, October 24th at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive. A presentation is planned which will provide an overview and brief history of the open space program, a review of the current Encroachment Enforcement Program and issues, and continuing discussion on the possible sale of open space under certain conditions. The workshop may be of interest to residents with existing or corrected encroachments and residents who purchased open space under earlier programs. Residents who have questions and concerns, and those who would like to learn more or provide input about the Open Space Encroachment program and possible changes, are encouraged to attend. Residents who have an interest in and enjoy open space in Chino Hills, and Homeowner's Associations that manage property adjacent to open space areas, may also want to attend.
