HICKORY CREEK PARK AND NATURE TRAIL CLOSED FOR MAINTENANCE FEBRUARY 5TH - FEBRUARY 14TH

A section of Hickory Creek Park and nature trail, in Chino Hills, will be closed for maintenance during posted hours from February 5th to February 14th. The Park closure will start at Rolling Ridge Drive and continue east to Pipeline Avenue. The City will close the Park and nature trail weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and on Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., in order to allow crews to clear the creek of heavy vegetation and to prepare the site for upcoming construction. Improvements will include bank stabilization, stream bed enhancements, and landscaping with native trees, groundcover, and shrubs. Park and trail access points will be blocked at Rolling Ridge Drive, Willow Lane, and Pipeline Avenue. All access is prohibited during posted hours to allow crews and equipment to work safely.
