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PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION APPLICATIONS SOUGHT Applications due February 26th

Council Member Peter Rogers is seeking applications from Chino Hills residents who are interested in serving on the Public Works Commission to fill the vacancy created when Barry Fischer resigned from the Commission on January 29th. Interested persons should return a completed application to the Chino Hills City Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 26th. Public Works Commission Applications on file at the City Clerk's Office and less than two years old will also be considered.

Interviews will be scheduled and the nomination of a Public Works Commissioner is expected to be made at the March 11th City Council meeting. Members of the City Council must affirm the appointment. The new Commissioner's term will be effective through the end of Council Member Rogers' term - November 30, 2014.

The Public Works Commission meets on the first Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. to review issues related to public safety, cable television, water, water rates, sewer, and roads. The Public Works Commission also considers traffic-related concerns such as stop signs, speed humps, and traffic signals.
