PET FAIR DAY – JUNE 7th

There will be lots of pets and fun at the City of Chino Hills Pet Fair on Saturday June 7th from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center, 14280 Peyton Drive. Enter the pet photo contest by submitting your favorite pet photo online at www.chinohills.org/PetFair, or at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center by June 4th. Photos of all kinds of pets may be submitted. Dogs brought to the event should have a current rabies vaccination and be socialized. Aggressive dogs will be excused from the McCoy property. Other kinds of pets may be brought to the event and must be in appropriate cages or on a leash.

Dog Fun events include contests for costumes, tail-wagging, sweetest dog, best rescue, amazing pet tricks, and more. There will also be a beginning agility contest and a “Simon Says” event for dogs. Stop by the McCoy Equestrian Center or the Recreation Division at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, to pre-register for the Dog Fun events by June 4th. If space is available, contest entries will be accepted at the event on a first-come, first-served basis. The cost is \$5 per entry or \$20 for unlimited entries in the Dog Fun events. Check-in at 10:30 a.m. for Dog Fun events which start at 1:00 p.m.

The Pet Fair Day will feature pet vendors, information booths, pet rescue organizations, low cost vaccinations, and pet adoptions. A K-9 demonstration is scheduled at noon.
