### **RESIDENTS MAY REGISTER ONLINE & BY MAIL FOR SWIM LESSONS ON JUNE 2<sup>nd</sup>**

Chino Hills residents receive priority registration for summer swim lessons. Online and mail-in registration for residents begins on Monday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:30 a.m. Complete information is available in the Summer City News & Recreation Brochure which was mailed to all households in mid-May. The brochure is also available online at [www.chinohills.org/RecOnline](http://www.chinohills.org/RecOnline). Mail-in registration with a postmark date prior to May 30<sup>th</sup> will be returned to the sender.

Participants receive two weeks of Red Cross swim instruction by City staff who are certified in CPR, First Aid, Water Safety Instruction, and Lifeguard Training. Lessons are approximately 30 minutes and each instructor has four to six kids per lesson. Children may only be enrolled in one class per session and all swimmers must be potty trained. Classes are open to kids from age 3 to 16 and older (including adults) and are grouped by ages. The cost for residents is \$55 per session.

A limited number of private one-on-one swim lessons are offered this year for the first time. The cost is \$135 per session. Sessions 1 and 2 will be held at Chino Hills High School, 16150 Pomona Rincon Road. Session 1 meets from June 23<sup>rd</sup> – July 3<sup>rd</sup> and session 2 meets from July 7<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>. Classes are held Mondays through Fridays starting at 11:00 a.m. through 3:05 p.m. Session 1 receives nine days of instruction due to the Fourth of July holiday.

Sessions 3 and 4 will be held at Ayala High School, 14255 Peyton Drive. Session 3 is from July 21<sup>st</sup> to August 1<sup>st</sup>. Session 3 classes start times begin at 11:00 a.m. and continue until 3:00 p.m. Session 4 meets from August 4<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> and includes later start times from 2:30 to 6:35 p.m.

Non-residents and walk-in registration will start at 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 11<sup>th</sup> if class space is still available. The cost for non-residents is \$65 per student. Walk-in registration will be available at the Chino Hills Community Center, 14250 Peyton Drive, and at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive. Please call (909) 364-2700 for additional information.
