SPACE AVAILABLE IN THE FALL TINY TOTS PROGRAM

Chino Hills residents may still register for a few open seats in the City of Chino Hills' popular Tiny Tots program which teaches kids, ages 3 to 5, academic and socialization skills to help prepare them for kindergarten. The kids participate in a variety of activities including games, craft projects, and supervised free time. Registration is underway in the Recreation Division at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive. Chino Hills residents should bring proof of residency, a photo identification, and a birth certificate to register. Children must be potty trained to attend Tiny Tots; and parents or guardians must register their own children. Open enrollment for non-residents begins August 18th if space is available.

Level One participants must be age 3 by August 26, 2014 for the Fall I session which is offered from August 25th through October 3rd. Level One classes meet from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. or from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The cost is \$82. Level Two participants must be age 4 by September 1, 2014 and eligible to start kindergarten in the fall of 2015. Level Two classes meet from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. or from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. The cost is \$92 for Level Two. Classes are offered at the Mystic Canyon Community Building, 6424 Mystic Canyon, in the Butterfield Ranch Area.
