WATCH FOR LOWER SPEED LIMITS IN CHINO HILLS!

Motorists may notice speed limit signs with bright orange flags on some arterial streets in Chino Hills. The flags have been installed to draw attention to new lower speed limits. California Vehicle Code requires that the City set speed limits based upon the 85th percentile which is the speed at, or below which, 85 percent of the traffic is moving. New Engineering and Traffic surveys were recently completed and some speed limits will be lowered as a result. In most cases, speed limits were reduced to enhance safety due to accident history, proximity of schools or driveways, roadway curves, visibility, or roadway conditions.
