Residents who are interested in serving on the Public Works Commission are invited to complete an application for consideration. Applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's Office on the second floor at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, by 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, November 26th.

The Public Works Commission meets on the first Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. to review issues related to public safety, cable television, water, water rates, sewer, and roads. The Public Works Commission also considers traffic-related concerns such as stop signs, speed humps, and traffic signals.
