Residents who are interested in serving on the Planning Commission are invited to complete an application for consideration. Council Member Peter Rogers will review the applications and make a selection to fill a vacancy created after Planning Commission Chair Julie Allen submitted her resignation due to increasing work commitments. Applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's Office on the second floor at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 13th.

The Planning Commission meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to development and building and safety. The Commission also reviews site plans, amendments to the Development Code and General Plan, residential designs, design standards, and development standards.
