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COMMUNITY INFORMATION MEETING ON BUSINESS ATTRACTION THURSDAY, MARCH 19TH

The City of Chino Hills is hosting a series of three Community Information Meetings to provide residents with background and information on various topics.

“The Council Members and I often hear the same series of questions from residents,” said Mayor Cynthia Moran. “We decided to schedule these meetings to give residents the opportunity to learn more about these topics like how we attract new businesses, public safety, and lighting and landscape in Chino Hills.”

The first meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 19th at the Chino Hills Community Center, 14250 Peyton Drive. Residents will learn how the City works to attract desirable stores, restaurants, and businesses. City Manager Rad Bartlam will provide an overview of the Business Attraction and Retention Program. The City's commercial real estate consultants will provide a presentation on trends in the market, what role the population statistics play when businesses make decisions, and more. Community Development Director Joann Lombardo will take questions from the audience and provide closing comments.

The Community Information Meeting on public safety will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 9th at the Chino Hills Community Center.
