### SUMMARY

On March 26, 2015 at about 1412 hours, Bugarin gained entry into a residence in the city of Chino Hills through an unlocked door. Once inside the residence, Bugarin began to ransack a sunroom located in the south area of the residence while the homeowners were in the living room watching television. After the homeowners heard an object fall in the sunroom, they walked to the room and found Bugarin in the process of burglarizing their home. One of the homeowners confronted Bugarin at which point she attempted to flee before the homeowner tackled Bugarin to the floor and detained her while his wife called 911.

Deputies arrived on scene shortly after the call to 911 and took custody of Bugarin. During the investigation deputies discovered Bugarin was currently on active felony probation for burglary and possibly under the influence of a controlled substance. Bugarin was subsequently arrested for burglary and a probation violation and booked in to West Valley Detention Center. Neither victim was injured during the incident.
