### **APRIL 19 SPRING HOME TOUR BENEFITS CITY PROGRAMS, PARKS, SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Chino Hills Community Foundation's 5<sup>th</sup> annual Spring Home Tour returns this year on Sunday, April 19 with an impressive lineup of homes that highlight the diverse community of Chino Hills.

Tours will take place from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. with a wine reception to follow from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the Chino Hills Community Center. Tickets are \$45 per person which includes the tour and reception. Tickets can be purchased for \$30 for those who may want to attend the reception only. Proceeds from the event will contribute to the Foundation's efforts to raise funds for art programs and youth and senior recreation scholarships.

The tour will feature three grand properties, located in different parts of the City. The tours are self-guided, and numerous docents will be on-hand to share information about the homes.

"We have an amazing selection of homes that really showcase what is special and unique about Chino Hills," said event chairwoman Sylvia Nash.

A wine reception with light appetizers will cap off the day where guests have the opportunity to buy raffle tickets and enjoy live music.
