Crime or Incident: PC 21310- Possession of an Illegal Weapon

Location: Chino Hills Parkway / Pipeline Ave., Chino Hills, CA

Suspect (s): Michael Williams, 42 years of age, resident of Chino Hills, CA

SUMMARY: On Tuesday, April 21, 2015, at approximately 1639 hours, the Multiple Enforcement Team contacted Michael Williams after he was observed sleeping on the sidewalk next to the front door of a business. During the investigation, deputies determined Williams had been drinking alcoholic beverages and was intoxicated. A search of Williams person revealed he was armed with an assortment of knives, including a 6" dagger.

Deputies discovered Williams was on supervised probation for domestic violence, as a result of California Assembly Bill 109.

As part of Governor Jerry Brown's Realignment Plan, or Assembly Bill 109, to comply with a U.S. Supreme Court decision requiring the state to lower its prison population by 30,000; offenders with non-violent, non-sexual and non-serious convictions will serve reduced sentences in county jails and be placed on local supervision through County Probation.

Deputies transported Williams to the West Valley Detention Center where he remains in custody in lieu of no bail.
