### SUMMARY:

On Friday, April 03, 2015, the Chino Hills Police responded to the 4700 block of Chino Hills Parkway to investigate a theft report. Deputies from Chino Hills Station and Multiple Enforcement Team conducted an investigation, which led to the identification of Joshua Charbonnet, a resident based out of the Corona area. Charbonnet was identified as the suspect in a string of commercial thefts at several Lowe's Home Improvement stores throughout the Inland Empire.

On Thursday, April 23, 2015, the Chino Hills Sheriff's Department executed a search warrant at Charbonnet's residence, located at 13000 Fescue Court in the city of Corona. At the home, deputies discovered additional evidence, which linked Charbonnet to the various theft incidents. Deputies booked Charbonnet at the West Valley Detention Center where he remains in custody with bail set at \$50,000.
