Date/Time Occurred: Thursday, May 7, 2014

Crime or Incident: P.C. 182, Conspiracy to commit burglary / P.C. 466, Possession of burglary tools.

Location: Avenida Hacienda/ Windmill Creek, City of Chino Hills

Suspects: Odell, Atraiu (Age 26)
Belgrove, Jabrii (Age 20)
Childs, Theron (Age 18)

SUMMARY:

On May 7, 2015 an alert Chino Hills resident noticed the three above suspects in a black older model Nissan Maxima. The suspects were seen parked in the area of Avenida Hacienda and Windmill Creek Road possibly casing homes. The concerned citizen called Sheriff's Dispatch Center to report the suspicious activity. Deputies quickly responded to the call for service.

Upon contact, deputies learned Odell was currently on probation for Possession for sales, Belgrove was on active parole for burglary; and Childs was out on bail for a previous arrest in another county. A subsequent search by deputies led to the discovery of a radio scanner programmed to the Chino Hills Police radio frequency, a spring loaded center punch (commonly used for breaking windows) and rubber gloves. All three suspects were found to be residents of Riverside County. The three suspects were arrested for being in possession of burglary tools and conspiracy to commit burglary.

After the arrest, Odell was determined to be on probation for Possession for sales and recently released from State Prison under the Assembly Bill 109-(Prisoner Realignment.) Deputies booked Odell, Belgrove and Childs at the West Valley Detention Center. Odell and Childs are currently in custody in lieu of \$30,000 bail each. Belgrove is being held on a no bail parole hold.
