STUDENT MEMBER SOUGHT FOR HEALTHY CITIES STEERING COMMITTEE APPLICATIONS DUE JUNE 19th

High school and college students who would like to gain some interesting experience are encouraged to apply to serve on the Chino Hills Healthy Cities Steering Committee. The Committee includes three high school student members and one college student. High school students must live in Chino Hills and/or attend high school in the City. The high school student must be a junior or senior during the 2015/2016 school year and must be in good academic standing. College students must be enrolled in college-level courses, and must live in Chino Hills and/or have parents residing in Chino Hills. The Healthy Cities Steering Committee meets quarterly at 6:00 p.m. to review and discuss items relating to parks, recreation, community events and programs designated as Healthy Cities focus areas. Meetings are held in February, May, August and November. The membership subcommittee will interview applicants starting the week of July 6th and they expect to recommend appointments for the three high school students and one college student to the Healthy Cities Steering Committee at their August 17, 2015 meeting. The new members will serve August 2015 through August 2016.
