Chino Hills Police Captain Robert Guillen provided information about public safety and law enforcement in Chino Hills, the challenges and benefits of social media, crime statistics, and trends. Captain Guillen also provided information about instances where the Chino Hills Police Department caught criminals with help from the public. Code Enforcement’s role in a safe community was also reviewed. The meeting ended with a question and answer period.
