SUMMARY

On Friday, July 24, 2015 at approximately 2108 hours, a fatal traffic collision occurred at the intersection of Terrace Drive and Chino Hills Parkway within Chino Hills. The intersection of Terrace Drive and Chino Hills Parkway is an uncontrolled T shaped intersection with Terrace Drive terminating into Chino Hills Parkway.

The investigation revealed the victim had been walking south across Chino Hills Parkway at the intersection of Terrace Drive. The victim was in the #2 eastbound lane of traffic when he was struck by a vehicle driven by Fredrick Menor.

Witness statements describe Menor traveling at approximately 40-50 miles hour in the #2 eastbound traffic lane when the collision occurred. Menor stated he was passing an unrelated vehicle that was in the #1 lane when he noticed the victim in the roadway. Menor attempted to avoid the collision by turning toward the left entering the #1 eastbound lane. He was not able to avoid the collision resulting in the front passenger side bumper and fender striking the victim.

The impact caused the victim to become airborne and he came to rest approximately 20 feet from the point of impact. The victim was able to remove himself from the roadway as witnesses and Menor stopped to render assistance. The victim sustained severe injuries in the collision. The victim was transported via ambulance to Arrowhead Regional Medical Center in Colton where he succumbed to his injuries. Menor was cooperative with investigators and was released from the scene.

At this point, it is unknown if speed and/or alcohol were contributing factors to the collision. Anyone who may have witnessed the collision or who might have additional information pertinent to the case is encouraged to contact investigators at the numbers listed below.
