SUMMARY

Deputies from the Chino Hills Police Station responded to the Mission Hills Apartments reference a burglary from a vehicle. The suspect broke the passenger window of the victim's vehicle and took a laptop computer and an Apple iPad. The victim was able to activate the Find My iPad App which led deputies to the 13300 block of Saddle Ln in the City of Chino. The Chino Hills Detective Bureau also responded and located a stolen vehicle parked on the street occupied by Cebreros. Cebreros was taken into custody without incident. The vehicle was found to have property, including the stolen iPad, from at least six victims from Chino and Chino Hills. Through investigative leads, Deputies determined an additional stolen vehicle was used. The second stolen vehicle was located at 4200 Village Drive in the City of Chino Hills. Cebreros was booked into the West Valley Detention Center.
