OCT. 10 CHINO HILLS WINE WALK SUPPORTS TRAILS, PARKS, AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Premier California wines and local restaurants are the focal point of the 5th annual Chino Hills Wine Walk on Saturday, Oct. 10 from 4:00 - 7:00 p.m. at The Shoppes at Chino Hills.

Advanced sale tickets are \$45 (day-of is \$55) and include 12 tickets to sample wine and small bites at a wine garden in the central courtyard and at numerous retailers throughout The Shoppes at Chino Hills. The EnCork after-party takes the evening into the night with a full dinner and a live auction. EnCork tickets are an additional \$60 ticket per person and are limited.

"We bring in only the best wines and pair them with tastes from some of our finest Chino Valley restaurants," said Chino Hills Community Foundation Chair Peter Rogers. "It's a great evening for people who enjoy food and wine."

All proceeds from the event benefit the Chino Hills Community Foundation, which is committed to enhancing the quality of life in the City. The Wine Walk will directly benefit new Foundation projects that include beautifying trails in Chino Hills and purchasing playground equipment for a future park in the Los Serranos neighborhood.

More than 20 wines from California and abroad will be featured with restaurants that include: Bruxie, California Pizza, Corner Bakery, Corner Butcher Shop, The Kickin' Crab, Owen's Bistro, Papachino's, P.F. Chang's China Bistro, The Pub at Chino Hills, RA Sushi, Roscoe's, and more.
