**SEPTEMBER 16TH & 17TH
PEYTON DRIVE, ANOTHER ROUTE WILL BE A BETTER ROUTE
36-HOUR CLOSURE PLANNED ON EUCALYPTUS AVENUE**

The Peyton Drive project bypass road will be in use during the morning commute and school traffic period on Thursday, September 17th. Another route WILL be a better route! The decision to allow the closure was made to allow the contractor to complete the box culvert under Eucalyptus Avenue during one last major period which will reduce impacts in the future. Commuters and motorists whose destination is not on Peyton Drive are urged to avoid the area. This is the first time the bypass road will be in use during morning traffic with school in session.

Motorists on Eucalyptus Avenue will be directed to the bypass road and on to Peyton Drive from Wednesday, September 16th at approximately 7:30 a.m. (after the Ayala H.S. traffic) till approximately 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 17th. Fall sports participants traveling to Chino Hills Community Park during the closure are encouraged to carpool and to travel to and from the park using the route from Chino Hills Parkway and Eucalyptus Avenue to avoid the bypass road and traffic.

PLEASE plan ahead for the traffic delays and allow extra time. Motorists with smartphones are encouraged to take advantage of the OxBlue app to check real time road conditions on the two webcams that are operational 24/7. Motorists are also advised to slow down in the construction area for the safety of the workers.
